ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the Olympic EcSA program, a customer must:

1. Be 18 or older.
2. Be legally entitled to work in the United States.
3. Be low income, and/or receiving assistance through Basic Food or TANF.

In addition to the above, one or more of the following must be true:

- Customer has barriers to employment, lacks work experience, and/or specific skills necessary to enter the workforce.
- Household income is within low income requirements.

Special priority of service will be given to US Military veterans and eligible spouses of veterans.
