Find Naloxone (Narcan®) Near You

There are three ways to get naloxone in Washington State:

- 1) Pharmacy with prescription: Any prescriber can write a prescription for naloxone and any pharmacy can fill that prescription.
- 2) Pharmacy without prescription: Under Washington's Statewide Standing Order anyone can obtain naloxone directly from any pharmacy that carries it. A customer can get naloxone directly from a pharmacist without first seeing a provider.
 - ▶ It's best to call ahead to confirm naloxone availability, cost, and insurance coverage. Pharmacies may carry only one form of naloxone (such as intramuscular or intranasal).
- 3) Community programs: Many harm reduction syringe service programs and other community programs distribute naloxone, although some only give naloxone to clients. Contact the program to find out.





Want naloxone delivered to your home?

Like many other medications, naloxone can be mailed or dropped off. Contact your local pharmacy to see if they carry naloxone, and if they offer delivery or mail order. Under the statewide standing order a pharmacy can directly prescribe you naloxone, and charge your insurance, and send it to you.

Insurance Coverage

- ♦ Washington Medicaid covers most forms of naloxone with no co-pay, and most plans have no limits on the number of kits that can be obtained in a year.
- Most commercial health insurance plans cover at least one form of naloxone. Coverage and co-pays vary by plan.
